We were blessed early on in the summer with very few corona cases here in Croatia (it's a bit of a different story now but more of that in the prayer requests) and as things opened up again in July, we were able to start church up again, our teen club and the toddler singing clubs met in person and we were able to run

### Church

# Masters in Christian Formation and Discipleship

The masters programme with YWAM's university which I (Jarod) was supposed to start in March has been postponed until October and we've been told to stay flexible with that date too. Although the first module

has not begun, we have been doing a personal formation track, which involved reading a couple of books, participating in some spiritual discipline practises and a 24 hour retreat. It's been a great time of growth and has helped me prepare for the work load which will start with module one.

#### Camps

We ran two camps this summer. The first was a day camp for kids aged 6 to 11 from 9am to 2pm each day. There were 40 kids and we had english class, games and swimming during the morning. Our camp theme for both camps was 'The Amazing Race - We're in this together' and our theme verse was Romans 12:10 "Be devoted to one another in love. Honour one another above yourselves." We wanted to share the message that God calls us to be unified, loving each other, especially with what is going on around the world. With a weeks break, we then had a teenager camp for five days with all of us camping in tents. The schedule was more relaxed with a devotion each morning and small group discussions. We had games and swimming and a talent show on the last night. The teens had a great week and were really open and vulnerable with each other and us. Jarod led the devotion on the last day on the power of encouragement and we ended by writing encouragements to each other. It was a special time.

We are so thankful we were able to run these camps especially as the kids and teens have had very little to do this summer.

### What's next?

It's hard to say what's next but our hopes are that;

- Jarod will be able to attend the first masters intensive in the UK in October.
- The virus cases will begin to decrease so we can start hosting outreach teams and retreats and that all our regular church groups and ministries can continue to function.
- We are praying as a team about new and creative ways we can serve our community with the changes that corona has brought.
- We believe God is leading us to focus more on the sailing side of our ministry, training people with sailing skills who want to work as missionaries on ships, and reaching more of the local
  Croatian community through sailing.
